- **dedicated training** in Warsaw in Nov 2017 on **social media management, project management**, (because we may ask a lot, but we want to give you some training!).
- **travel and accommodation expenses in the 6 events will be covered by us!** (It is soooo freeeeee... really, we pay for it, thanks to the EU funds we have received!)
- **professional development - you can list this as a professional experience!** (all this organising, networking, civic engagement will look sooooo goood on your CV!).
- **support, mentoring, visibility** to make sure you succeed (we are a team!).
- chance of **practicing English**.
- become part of a **big international team**, equals among equals!

What We Want From You

**Passion & Time (3 hours per week)
to achieve some goals:**

- **Reach** before each event at least **25 of your friends, colleagues, rivals, role models** and make sure they know about the events and that they **apply**. No one should be left behind! People with disadvantaged backgrounds, people at their first international experience are particularly welcome.
- **Organise debate parties** to support and vote their teams during the streaming of the debates happening during the events.
- Carry on a social **media campaign** and ensure the **visibility of the project on social media**.
- **Write 1 post per week** on the project blog and **1 entry per week** on the project diary, to share the amazing things you and your team are doing and to update the continent about the Message to the Europeans!
- Organise **follow-up activities locally** to spread the voice about the results of the project (organise an exhibition, a presentation, a flash-mob, a conference, **whatever YOU want, to spread out the Message to the Europeans!**)



You may earn a Special Role

Be a **moderator /secretary/ researcher** of a roundtable offers you the chance of researching on Populism, Economic Crisis, Migration Crisis, the Future of Europe.

For example you may:

- **Prepare**, with guidance, **materials** for the simulations, the debates, the mock-trials.
- Help out with **assessment and proceedings** during the event itself.

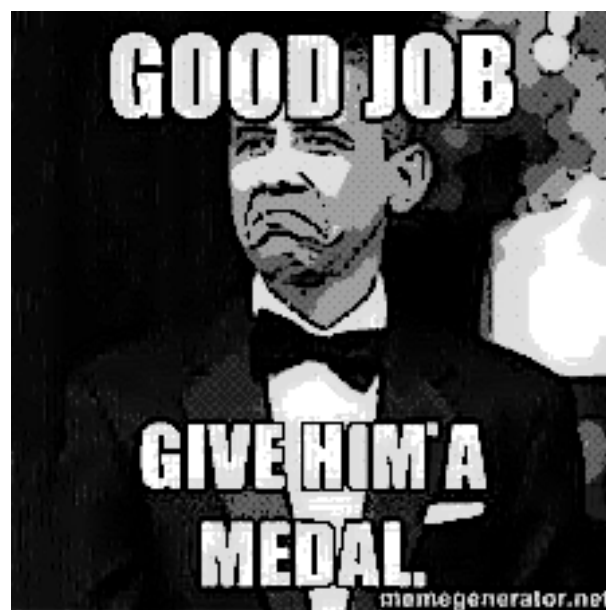
We will consider applications on a rolling basis from now until
